CURLING

FRIDAY games

- No points for a blank end
- Regular curling rules apply

SATURDAY games

- 4 ends
- Each end is worth 2 pts
- No points for a blank end
- Regular curling rules apply

DRAW TO THE BUTTON (Friday night)

- Each team chooses ONE member to throw to the button
- A broom holder and two sweepers are allowed
- Closest draw to the button wins \$100



GOLF – Best Ball

SATURDAY

- Each team will be given a designated hole to start at
- Horn will sound to commence play
- Fill in your scorecard and deposit in basket at club
- Darryl will finalize the score!

Scoring

- Double Bogey = 1 pt
- Bogey = 2 pts
- Par = 3 pts
- Birdie = 4 pts

At the same time, the other 8 teams will be splitting between curling & pickleball.




PICKLEBALL

SATURDAY

- 1 hour limit
- Two players needed (if short, other teams can donate a player to you)
- Each game played to 7 (have to win by two)
- Three games max
- Win is worth 3 pts
- Only completed games get points
- Paddles and balls supplied




BASIC PICKLEBALL RULES



- 1. The first team to serve is chosen at random (e.g. coin toss).
- 2. Only the team serving can score a point.
- 3. A team's first serve is always from the right-hand side of the court when facing the net.
- 4. Serves must be underhand and from behind the service line.
- 5. Serves must be delivered diagonally cross court.
- 6. If the serving team wins the rally, they score a point. If the serving team loses the rally, they lose the serve.

- 7. A rally is lost by the team that:
 - hits a ball that lands out of bounds
 - lets a ball bounce twice on their side
 - doesn't serve into the diagonal court
 - steps into the KITCHEN (no-volley zone) to volley a ball
 - violates the Two Bounce Rule on the serve
- 8. The Two Bounce Rule: On the serve, the receiving team must let the ball bounce once before hitting it back, and then the serving team must also let the ball bounce once on their side before hitting it back. After that you can volley the ball or wait for it to bounce before hitting it back.
- 9. The team that serves first gets only one serve, and that's by the person standing on the right-hand side of the court. That player continues to serve if their team wins the rallies, switching from the right side to the left side and then back again with every point won. When their team loses a rally, the serve goes to the other team.
- 10. After the first serve of the game, the opposite team gets two serves. Again, start with the person on the right-hand side facing the net serving. That person serves and scores points until they lose their serve and then their teammate gets to serve from the side of the court they were last on. When the teammate loses their serve, the serve goes back to the other team and the game continues with two serves per team.
